Other Important Details:

We will assume that all children enrolled in our Summer Camp will be permitted to attend all field trips that are planned. If you do not wish for your child to participate, you must let us know in writing no later than the day prior to the field trip. (If it is a one-time event that requires a minimum number of children in order to receive a reduced rate and you pull your child out after the deadline has passed, you will still be responsible for your child's admission fee.)

The cost of the one-time events will vary based on the general admission fee of each activity. Field trips more than 60 miles away may cost a few extra dollars for gas.
